

LES VERNES WASH HOUSE

The wash houses provided to local populations served not only as a place for the women do the laundry, but were also places of discussion and chit-chat. In the early 20th century, every district in Moirans had its wash house.

The inhabitants of Les Vernes, Champ Chevallier and the nearby districts in the islands used Moirans' last remaining wash house. It provided more comfortable conditions for the laundry women, who no longer had to kneel on the banks of the Erignière stream to beat their washing.
