

Maison Trenonay

This imposing residence belonged to nobleman Jacques Trenonay “La Montagne” (1610-1676), captain and châtelain of Moirans. He was the grandfather of the Pâris brothers.

The house has three storeys with a beautiful spiral staircase encased in a hexagonal tower. The staircase, lit on the west side, is decorated with a series of mullioned windows, which now overlook a courtyard. The eastern façade has preserved certain elements of the modern era. Large windows were added during the 19th century, altering the southern façade.
